Message from Managing Director - Jim Armstrong

We've hit the ground running with a very busy start to the year. We are currently completing extensive testing in preparation for the release of ibais and DesignBAIS version 7.

This release will be staggered over the next few months and the first site is already running live. We'll be in contact with more details once a release schedule has been finalised.

Some of the changes with this release include the move to .NET technology which enables ibais to be fully compatible with other popular browsers such as Chrome, Safari, Edge and Firefox. We have also taken the opportunity to update the system security profile to take account of the latest threats and we're looking at dual factor authentication to add another level of security.

In addition, we've added the ability to encrypt our databases and also to have transactions fully replicated to a separate server (please contact us if you are interested in these options.)

Have You Updated?

New Web Server

In March 2017 we issued details of our new Webservers via News@BAIS and other email communication. However, it appears we have some clients who are still using the old webserver (https://designbais.bais.com.au/ibais/) to connect to ibais.

This old address will be switched off in the near future so it is important that ALL staff are made aware and update their shortcuts and favourites to use the new address as soon as possible. The correct address to access ibais is: https://ibais.com.au/ibais/



Displaying VIP Description or Classification Code

If you would like to display either the VIP description or Classification/ANZIC Code from the Client Record when in the Client Processing screen this can be enabled. Log a support call and advise which of these two fields you want displayed and it will be enabled and will then display where shown below:



Creating Client Codes

Are you aware that some characters *cannot* be used if you are using Sunrise, SVU and/or any other third party system where we communicate via xml? This means that the following should be avoided:

- In addition, avoid copying and pasting
- " where special characters might be
- ' inadvertently copied eg: Café
- The accent on the e will cause issues.

Showing Credit Card Fees on Invoices

If you want to charge your client a credit card fee to cover your cost for these transactions you can include the % value, the \$ amount and the total payable (including the fee) on your invoice, similar to the example below:


